

#### Golf Course & Landscape Maintenance - Mike Perham, Director

In an effort to improve the aesthetics of our roadways in the community next week when we mow the grass we will have slightly decreased the height of cut at which we mow. This slight decrease in height will help remove some of the brown leaf tissue that the grass is exhibiting from the frosts we have incurred this winter. The frost damage is much more obvious in the areas where Bermuda grass is the primary grass present. Following our mowing practices, we will be applying a foliar fertilizer to assist with the grass green up. We are optimistic that with the warmer weather we will be experiencing next week these practices will start to restore the green color to our roadway grasses.

We have started brushing programs to the greens on the Pines and Lakes courses to help improve putting quality. The overseeding on the Lakes greens is laying over, and these practices will help stand the grass up. This will also aid in getting sunlight into our base Bermuda grass so that it will start to grow with the warmer temperatures we are experiencing. We are also in the process of lowering the height of cut on all the greens to improve putting quality. There is very little overseeding on the Hills greens, and we will occasionally brush them to stand the grass up.
