As you may know, there was a recent news report that noted that the TPCA restaurant kitchen had numerous violation warnings during an inspection which occurred on Friday, February 5th. The inspector then made a follow-up inspection on Tuesday, February 9th to ensure that all items had been corrected, which they were. Upon learning of these violation warnings, we immediately followed up with our restaurant contractor to ensure that our facilities were currently in full compliance and that our future expectations for both compliance and notification were clearly understood. Nick Sessa and Chef Kevin Howe take food safety issues very seriously and have reassured us that that these recent inspection results will not be repeated. We believe our residents should have every confidence that their dining experiences will be well supervised, compliant with industry standards and thoroughly enjoyable.

I'd like to share a frustrating incident with you and ask for your assistance. Since reopening the Grand Pines Golf Course last fall, we've had ropes and rope stakes placed in areas that receive heavy traffic. We realize that rope on the courses is unpopular; however we would be negligent in our duties if we weren't trying to preserve grass areas from being decimated by cart traffic. We attempt to be diligent and rotate the rope locations as frequently as possible to minimize the inconvenience in any one particular area. We are entering the busiest six week period of the year for traffic on our courses, and the ropes are a very necessary evil.

Now the unfortunate part! We have a resident/golfer who has taken it upon themselves to vandalize our ropes on an all too frequent basis. This individual cuts our ropes into multiple pieces in an effort to persuade us to remove them. Their efforts have been fruitless, as we will not be swayed in our resolve to perform our duties. This damage is negatively impacting all residents, as we are constantly replacing the ropes that are damaged. Please pay particular attention in the late afternoon and early evening to anyone you see on the courses that stops and spends time in an area where our ropes are located. If you think you witness vandalism occurring, please obtain the trackage number on the golf cart and report it to security.
